REPORTS

Dan Carson was present to give the Site Council report. He updated the board on the happenings for the 2015-2016 school

year which included an adult woodworking class (5 adults) and a 'Visit Your School Day'. Site Council also facilitated Cougars and Cubs which is set up similar to Big Brother/Big Sisters where high school students are paired with elementary students. They also provided water and cookies during Pride in Your School Day. Mr. Carson commented that Site Council used to be mainly a way the administration got information out to patrons but once Mrs. Angelos started working with them, things really started happening.

Superintendent Angelos reported the fire alarms on the lower floor had been updated and the company will come back and replace the ones in the high school gym once the floor had cured. The system is being more customized to the size of the school.

Superintendent Angelos reported that since kindergarten classes in most schools is now full time, next year, we will be going full days from the beginning of the year.

The final walk through for the window project will be next week. Levi Pochop Pochop will be starting the finish work on the interior of the classrooms.

The district house will be receiving some updates prior to the Homburgs moving in which include new carpet throughout the house, painting of several rooms, shower repairs and a new dishwasher.

A grant to replace the lights in both of the Bird City gyms has been submitted to the Dane Hansen Foundation Foundation.

Cheylin Recreation Commission has agreed to purchase some equipment for the Wellness Center and a set of shorter standards for the goals in the elementry gym.

DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS

The board members toured the facilities to see the projects. The board discussed possible updates to the high school gym exterior entrance. Superintendent Angelos will obtain a bid for sandblasting back to the original concrete and painting. A bid to replace the south exterior gym door will also be obtained. The evergreen tree near the entrance was also discussed and it was the concensus of the board to see if the tree can be trimmed.

Wade Carmichel and David Hendricks, Bird City Century II Board members, were present to discuss obtaining some of the school's property to build a daycare. Three of the school board members met with BC Century II and viewed the plans. The facility will be a house-type structure with a full basement. The exterior will be siding with faux stone to the base of the windows on the front and heritage shingles. BCCII would like the facility entrance to face the south to be more visable and to accomodate for parking, snow removal, etc. Mr. Carmichael and Mr. Hendricks reiterated that BCCII Development Foundation has recommitted to economic development and acknowledges the importance of keeping the school open. They have been told by advisors that one of the first things young people moving to the community are looking for is adequate daycare.
